

**INVITATION OF APPLICATIONS FOR THE POST OF TGT, PRT, NTT, MUSIC
TEACHER AND GAMES TEACHER IN AIR FORCE SCHOOL AMLA FOR
EMPANELMENT DURING ACADEMIC SESSION 2025-26**

1. Applications are invited from eligible candidates for the post of Trained Graduate Teacher, Primary Teacher, Nursery Trained Teacher, Music Teacher and Games Teacher in Air Force School Amla. The eligibility conditions are as given below:-

2. **Trained Graduate Teacher (TGT): Hindi & Sanskrit (Contactual Post)**

(a) **Mandatory Qualifications**

(i) A Masters or a Bachelor's Degree from any University recognised by the Govt of India/ UGC/ AICTE with a minimum marks of 50 percent in the subject and 50 percent in the aggregate. The candidate must have studied Hindi with Sanskrit as an elective subject at Degree level.

(ii) A Bachelor of Education Degree or its equivalent from a college/ university recognised by Govt of India/AICTE/UGC/National Council of Teachers Education.

(iii) Should be in the age group of 21 to 50 years as on 01 July 2025.

(iv) Women candidates and physically challenged candidates will be given age relaxation upto a maximum of five years.

(v) Ex-servicemen candidates who have put in not less than six months of continuous service in the Army, Navy or the Air Force shall be allowed to deduct the period of such service from their actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for the post by more than three years, they shall be deemed to have satisfied the condition regarding age limit. Such ex-servicemen candidates, if selected for the post, will also retire from the School as per rules of the Society.

(vi) Candidates with atleast two years continuous service as a PGT/TGT or three years as a PRT/NTT in any Air Force School but presently not working in an Air Force School, will be given age relaxation upto the extent of such service rendered in Air Force School.

(vii) Should be able to read, write and communicate fluently in English (except TGT Hindi, Sanskrit, Games and Drawing).

(b) **Desirable Qualifications**

(i) Knowledge of computer applications, especially MS Office.

(ii) Ability to read/write/communicate in Hindi.

(iii) CTET/STET qualified candidates will be given additional weightage during selection.

3. Trained Graduate Teacher (TGT): English & Social Studies (Contactual Post)

(a) Mandatory Qualifications

(i) A Masters or a Bachelor's Degree from any University recognised by the Govt of India/ UGC/ AICTE with a minimum marks of 50 percent in the subject and 50 percent in the aggregate. The candidate must have studied English as one subject with any two out of History, Geography, Economics or Political Science, of which one must be either History or Geography at Graduation level.

(ii) A Bachelor of Education Degree or its equivalent from a college/ university recognised by Govt of India/AICTE/UGC/National Council of Teachers Education.

(iii) Should be in the age group of 21 to 50 years as on 01 July 2025.

(iv) Women candidates and physically challenged candidates will be given age relaxation upto a maximum of five years.

(v) Ex-servicemen candidates who have put in not less than six months of continuous service in the Army, Navy or the Air Force shall be allowed to deduct the period of such service from their actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for the post by more than three years, they shall be deemed to have satisfied the condition regarding age limit. Such ex-servicemen candidates, if selected for the post, will also retire from the School as per rules of the Society.

(vi) Candidates with atleast two years continuous service as a PGT/TGT or three years as a PRT/NTT in any Air Force School but presently not working in an Air Force School, will be given age relaxation upto the extent of such service rendered in Air Force School.

(vii) Should be able to read, write and communicate fluently in English (except TGT Hindi, Sanskrit, Games and Drawing).

(b) Desirable Qualifications

(i) Knowledge of computer applications, especially MS Office.

(ii) Ability to read/write/communicate in Hindi.

(iii) CTET/STET qualified candidates will be given additional weightage during selection.

4. Trained Graduate Teacher (TGT): Mathematics & Science (Contactual Post)

(a) Mandatory Qualifications

(i) A Masters or a Bachelor's Degree from any University recognised by the Govt of India/ UGC/ AICTE with a minimum marks of 50 percent in the subject and 50 percent in the aggregate. The candidate must have studied Mathematics with any two out of Physics, Chemistry, Electronics, Computer Science or Statistics at Graduation level.

(ii) A Bachelor of Education Degree or its equivalent from a college/ university recognised by Govt of India/AICTE/UGC/National Council of Teachers Education.

(iii) Should be in the age group of 21 to 50 years as on 01 July 2025.

(iv) Women candidates and physically challenged candidates will be given age relaxation upto a maximum of five years.

(v) Ex-servicemen candidates who have put in not less than six months of continuous service in the Army, Navy or the Air Force shall be allowed to deduct the period of such service from their actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for the post by more than three years, they shall be deemed to have satisfied the condition regarding age limit. Such ex-servicemen candidates, if selected for the post, will also retire from the School as per rules of the Society.

(vi) Candidates with atleast two years continuous service as a PGT/TGT or three years as a PRT/NTT in any Air Force School but presently not working in an Air Force School, will be given age relaxation upto the extent of such service rendered in Air Force School.

(vii) Should be able to read, write and communicate fluently in English (except TGT Hindi, Sanskrit, Games and Drawing).

5. **Primary Teachers (Contractual Post)**

(a) **Mandatory Qualifications**

(i) A Bachelor's Degree from any University recognised by the Govt of India/UGC/AICTE, with minimum marks of 50 percent in the aggregate.

(ii) A Bachelor of Education Degree or its equivalent from a college/ university recognised by Govt of India/AICTE/UGC/National Council of Teachers Education.

(iii) Should be in the age group of 21 to 50 years as on 01 July 2025.

(iv) Women candidates and physically challenged candidates will be given age relaxation upto a maximum of five years.

(v) Ex-servicemen candidates who have put in not less than six months of continuous service in the Army, Navy or the Air Force shall be allowed to deduct the period of such service from their actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for the post by more

than three years, they shall be deemed to have satisfied the condition regarding age limit. Such ex-servicemen candidates, if selected for the post, will also retire from the School as per rules of the Society.

(vi) Candidates with at least two years continuous service as a PGT/TGT or three years as a PRT in any Air Force School but presently not working in an Air Force School, will be given age relaxation upto the extent of such service rendered in Air Force School.

(x) Should be able to read, write and communicate fluently in English.

(b) **Desirable Qualifications**

(i) Knowledge of computer applications, especially MS Office.

(ii) Ability to read/write/communicate in Hindi.

(iii) CTET/STET qualified candidates will be given additional weightage during selection.

6. **Nursery Trained Teachers (Permanent Post)**

(a) **Mandatory Qualifications.**

(i) Senior Secondary with Nursery Teachers Training diploma or diploma in Nursery/Montessori/Pre-Primary Teachers Training from a Govt recognised institution. While candidates with higher qualifications may apply, preference will be given to candidates with diploma in Nursery/Montessori Training.

(ii) Should be in the age group of 21 to 50 years as on 01 July 2025.

(iii) Women candidates and physically challenged candidates will be given age relaxation upto a maximum of five years.

(iv) Ex-servicemen candidates who have put in not less than six months of continuous service in the Army, Navy or the Air Force shall be allowed to deduct the period of such service from their actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for the post by more than three years, they shall be deemed to have satisfied the condition regarding age limit. Such ex-servicemen candidates, if selected for the post, will also retire from the School as per rules of the Society.

(v) Candidates with at least two years continuous service as a PGT/TGT/PRT in any Air Force School but presently not working in an Air Force School, will be given age relaxation upto the extent of such service rendered in Air Force School.

(vi) Should be able to read, write and communicate fluently in English.

(b) **Desirable Qualifications**

- (i) Basic knowledge of computer applications, especially MS Office.
- (ii) Should be able to read/write/communicate in Hindi.
- (iii) Experience in art, craft, cartoon, caricature, puppet making, music, dance etc.

7. **Music Teacher (Permanent Post)**

- (a) Degree in Music from a Govt recognised University **OR**
- (b) Higher Secondary with any of the following, viz., Sangeet Visharad of Gandharva Mahavidyalaya Mumbai **OR**
- (c) Bhatkhande Sangeet Vidyapeeth, Lucknow **OR**
- (d) Indira Kala Sangeet Vishwavidyalaya, Khairagarh (Chhattisgarh) **OR**
- (e) Sangeet Prabhakar Examination of Prayag Sangeet Samiti, Allahabad **OR**
- (f) Equivalent qualification from other Govt recognised institutions. **OR**
- (g) Degree/Diploma awarded by Pracheen Kala Kendra, Chandigarh in the following categories, viz., Sangeet Bhaskar with graduation in any discipline, Sangeet/ Nritya Bhushan with graduation in any discipline, Sangeet Bhushan with Sr Sec/ Sec/ Pt I of three-year degree course and Sangeet/ Nritya Visharad with Sr Sec/ Sec/ Pt I of three-year degree course **OR**
- (h) Any other equivalent course in Music.

8. **Games Teacher (Permanent Post)**. Degree in Physical Education or its equivalent from any Govt recognised institution.

9. The application (**as per the format given below**) alongwith photocopies of relevant documents / certificates to be submitted by hand at Station Education Section / Air Force School Amla by **05 January 2025**. Duly filled applications with relevant documents may also be forwarded on e-mail ID afschoollamla@gmail.com by **05 January 2025**. The selection process comprises of written test, teaching aptitude test and interview. The exact schedule of the tests will be intimated later to the candidates.
